## Qualification Requirements:

To successfully attain the Advanced Diploma of Project Management participants must:

- Attend a three day Advanced Diploma workshop. This workshop finalises the formal learning and supports participants in completion of the assessment process.
- Prepare and present a brief presentation based on learning from the workshop and pre-reading provided
- Complete assessment tasks against assessment elements defined in the Assessment Guide.
- Attend an assessment interview to review the assessment task documentary evidence and discuss the application of Project Management competencies within the workplace, and
- Complete the assessment within six months of the training

It is recommended that you be a practising Project and/or Program Manager currently managing projects or programs from an 'end-to-end' perspective. Typically you would have five or more years Project Management experience.
